USES

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

Spatial information can be used to prevent, prepare for, respond to and recover from emergency events. Specific uses for Points of Interest include identifying well-known locations to be used as public meeting points in the case of an emergency or identifying nearby hospitals and other emergency institutions.

LOCATION FINDER

Points of Interest combined with the latest mobile phone technology can show travellers an array of established services in the nearest suburb. For example, 'show me my nearest hospital' with the details returned almost immediately via their mobile service.

ONLINE STORE LOCATOR

Businesses can combine the details of their store locations with the Points of Interest dataset to display their store locations in relation to other well-known local features via the Internet.

IMPROVED TOURISM

Points of Interest allows tourism operators to improve their business. Digital mapping with cultural features enables tourists to plan the best itinerary that incorporates local facilities and attractions, such as museums.

INFORMATION SOURCES

Points of Interest was built and is maintained by PSMA Australia, utilising authoritative government data, sourced from the Commonwealth, state and territory government mapping agencies and land registries of Australia.

ACCESS
