PSMA's new data portal is the next stage in the evolution of the organisation's flagship product, Geoscape, allowing us to go direct to market and service industries and use cases that PSMA was previously unable to accommodate. The purpose of the data portal itself is to enable new and existing customers of PSMA to access our rich datasets in new ways that make sense to them and better suit their needs.
